WHO WE ARE:

Stand Up For Animals, Inc. (S.U.F.A.) is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization dedicated to animal welfare and protection. Founded in 1999, S.U.F.A. provides animal control services for Monroe County, FL. from MM 17 - 70. S.U.F.A. also operates the Marathon and Big Pine Shelters

in the Florida Keys and SUFA Second Chance Ranch in Traverse City , Michigan. All facilities are run under a no-kill policy – only severely ill, injured or aggressive animals are euthanized.

Thanks to dedicated staff and volunteers, we are proud of the quality of life offered to our animals. We strive to make their lives at the shelter as close to a home environment as possible, with daily walks, grooming, car trips, office days and one-on-one attention. Dogs are allowed to play together in outdoor yards and cats are kept cage-free in our cat room or outdoor enclosures.

WHAT WE DO:

- **Sheltering & Adoptions** – S.U.F.A. operates under an open door policy—no cats or dogs brought to our shelters are turned away. After vaccinations, altering and treatments for parasites, animals are placed for adoption. Each year, S.U.F.A. places hundreds of cats and dogs in loving homes.
- **Cruelty Investigations** – S.U.F.A. animal control officers investigate cruelty cases and file custody for abused and neglected animals. S.U.F.A. has been awarded custody of numerous animals, including four pit bulls found chained and neglected, "Nuke" a miniature pinscher mix who was beaten by his owner, "Capper" a macaw confined for years in a tiny cage, nine roosters that were used in cockfighting and 50 dogs rescued from a puppy mill in Marathon.
- **Legislation** – S.U.F.A. has successfully lobbied for animal protection laws, including ordinances restricting the chaining of dogs and the breeding of dogs and cats in Monroe County.



S.U.F.A. has altered more than 2,500 cats and dog in Monroe County since opening its Big Pine clinic in 2002.

- **Spaying and Neutering** – S.U.F.A.'s Big Pine Shelter houses our veterinary hospital which offers low-cost spay/neuter and free rabies clinics every month.
- **Community Outreach** – Dog walks with the public every Saturday morning at the Old Seven Mile Bridge in Marathon.
– Annual Animal Heroes Banquet honoring people who have made outstanding contributions to animal welfare.
- **Volunteer Opportunities** – S.U.F.A. volunteers walk dogs, brush cats, foster kittens and much more!
- **Education** – S.U.F.A. sponsors an annual animal law seminar for law enforcement offices in Monroe County. We also visit local schools promoting humane education.
